

# international PhD program at Universität Regensburg

In November 2014, the **international PhD program at Universität Regensburg (iPUR)** was constituted with support from the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD). The program aims to establish a structured and international post-graduate training at the **Faculty of Biology and Pre-Clinical Medicine** and at the **Faculty of Chemistry and Pharmacy** at Universität Regensburg (UR).

## ACTIVITIES FOR FOREIGN MASTERS AND PHD STUDENTS:

**iPUR** provides funding for the realization of short term study and research stays at the **Faculty of Chemistry & Pharmacy** or the **Faculty of Biology & Pre-Clinical Medicine**.

The offer is aimed at

- PhD students in the fields of Chemistry, Pharmacy, Biology or Biochemistry who want to accomplish a research stay at the UR (integrated thematically into their PhD thesis).
- Masters students in the fields of Chemistry, Pharmacy, Biology or Biochemistry who are interested to pursue a PhD at Universität Regensburg and want to get to know the city of Regensburg, the university and the possibilities for doctoral studies.

In case of funding, a travel and living allowance for up to three months (PhD students) or four weeks (Masters students) will be paid.
